Background:

The global pandemic and related mitigation measures have impacted the normal consumer price index (CPI) data collection and compilation processes. Given the tight compilation schedule and extensive price collection operations, the ramifications for CPI compilation are potentially significant, hindering the provision of key macroeconomic information at the time they are most needed.

Accurate and relevant inflation estimates are not only concern for the policymakers combatting the economic consequences of the current health crisis, but also households and firms taking action in the time of uncertainty. Reliable, trustworthy and transparent inflation estimates, regardless of the crisis impact on the national inflation, will enhance social cohesion and fight fake news.

This initial short course is meant for the GCC Statistics Offices CPI managers and senior staff with a broad understanding of the overall CPI production Depending on the participants' demand, a follow-up training, building upon agreed most relevant issues concerning the GCC CPI compilers, may be provided in relatively short notice.
